

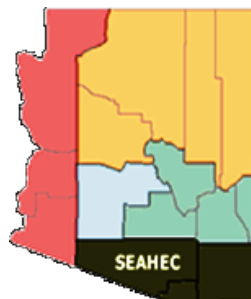
The Karen Halverson Memorial Scholarship Fund



Karen Halverson (1942 - 2009) was a champion of quality health care for people living in Nogales, Rio Rico, and throughout Southeastern Arizona. For 20 years from 1986 until 2006, she was administrator of Southeast Arizona Area Health Education Center (SEAHEC). In that capacity she successfully forged community partnerships to address a wide range of community health issues such as diabetes, asthma, obesity, lead poisoning, and healthcare provider shortages. Along with being an influential leader, she also was a great mentor to those considering health care professions.
